

ACCEPTED FORMS OF I.D. FOR PROVIDING PROOF OF IDENTITY

In order to verify the participant's identity the document that they provided should be a document containing a photo issued by a government or be issued by a commercial organisation for the purpose of proving proof of identity or age.

The document as a minimum must contain following information:

- participant's full name
- participant's photo
- date of birth
- document number

Following documents are some of the examples of identification documents that can be accepted as proof of identity:

- passport (Australian or International)
- driver's licence (Australian or International)
- driver's learners permit (Australian)
- boat operator's licence (Australian)
- firearm licence (Australian, must have photo)
- state, territory or federal government employee ID card (must have photo)
- other Australian government issued ID card (must have photo)
- photo identity card issued by a tertiary education institution
- government issued proof of age card
