


## What Is White Card Training Sydney?

- Known formally as Work Safely in the Construction Industry [CPCCOHS1001A](#), throughout NSW the course is more generally called White Card Training Sydney.
- One of the key strategies is all construction workers have training to understand their workplace responsibilities and rights, and are aware of the risks and hazards they could experience if employed in construction.
- Carefully designed to meet the requirements of [Safe Work Australia's White Card Training regulations](#), Edway's White Card Training Sydney is designed to be easily understood by school leavers, career changers, backpackers and anyone else who is seeking employment within NSW's strong-growth construction industries.

Safe Work Australia is a group made up from the Australian Government, the unions, and business representatives. It was originally put together to develop, and put in place practices to lower workplace accidents and incidents within the construction industries.
